

# Top Aberdeen airport hotel opens after £25m investment

Aberdeen's latest luxury hotel, the Crowne Plaza at Aberdeen International Airport, has opened after 18 months of construction.

Premium UK hospitality company Dominvs (Eds: correct) has invested £25 million in the 165-bedroom hotel which has created over 80 jobs for the local area.

The 165-bedroom hotel, which features a conferencing and events centre and state of the art amenities, is the ideal destination for business and leisure guests. Its Offshore Bar & Grill is a destination in itself and provides locally sourced produce as well as an extensive drinks list offering a wide array of fine whiskies.

The conference and events centre includes 10 meeting and event rooms with seating capacity for up to 300. These are fitted out with the latest technology, including video and audio streaming, touch screen control panels and retractable projection screens. It has a separate entrance and bar.
